ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the court upon consideration of Defendant Morgan Keegan & Company, Inc.'s ("Morgan Keegan") submission of discovery materials in electronic DVD format for *in camera* review, received by the court on March 5, 2012 (the "*In Camera* Submission")¹; and

THE COURT, having been unable to access and/or manage a material portion of the voluminous electronic *In Camera* Submission in the format provided by Morgan Keegan, hereby ORDERS that:

¹ The *In Camera* Submission was accompanied by two hard-copy privilege logs ("Privilege Log(s)"). The Privilege Logs are captioned, respectively, "Morgan Keegan Co. FINRA Inquiry re Blondeau" and "Morgan Keegan's Privilege Log for Production of March 5, 2012." The single-spaced Privilege Logs together are approximately 46 pages in length. They purport to seek protection from discovery, upon claim of privilege, of more than 1,000 documents that apparently are stored on the DVD.

1. Morgan Keegan shall submit to the court, in individual hard copy, each of the documents and other electronically stored information that constitutes the *In Camera* Submission.

2. Each of said documents shall be Bates stamped and organized in the same order as listed on each of the Privilege Logs. Each Privilege Log entry shall identify the corresponding Bates number(s) of the document it purports to represent.

3. The above documents shall be delivered to the court on or before 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 8, 2012.
